



Code of Conduct

Members are required to follow the Code of Conduct and associated Policies while onboard *South Passage* and during any activity associated with the Association

- Accept the aims, principles, methods, rules and policies of the Association
- Act responsibly and exercise a duty of care to others sailing on *South Passage*
- Not use the Association to promote their own beliefs, behaviours or practices where these are incompatible with the Association's
- Treat people with respect and accept a duty of care for the welfare, safety and health of fellow crew
- Respect everyone's right to personal privacy taking special care when sleeping, changing clothing, bathing and ablutions
- Avoid at all times compromising situations. This includes, but is not limited to, unaccompanied, unobserved and ambiguous meetings, discussions or activities with individuals that may give occasion for conjecture, rumour or adverse comment
- Conform to an appropriate standard of dress and conduct yourself in a manner befitting a member of the *South Passage* crew
- Act with courtesy, consideration and good judgement in all interpersonal relationships
- Adhere to the Association's policies of No Smoking, No Drugs and No Alcohol on board *South Passage*
- Accept that bullying, physical or verbal abuse, sexual harassment, neglect or any other type of abuse is unacceptable
